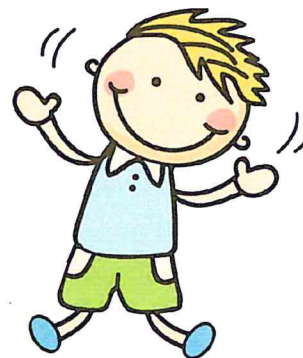
Our YMCA Active Kids Program is a safe, supervised place for children while their parents are using the YMCA facility and is staffed with attentive people who will nurture your child in a calm, positive, and healthy environment.

Active Kids is for children 6 weeks and up and will be located in the Active Kids Room, the gyms, Hang Time, Jr., as well as outdoors depending on the ages of the children attending and the available space. Please pick up a complete set of Active Kids guidelines and a current monthly calendar from the attendant.

FEES:



One or Two children	\$52.00/month
Three or more children	\$78.00/month
Hourly Rate	\$10.00/hour



Your Active Kids fee will need to be paid monthly through our Automatic Check Withdraw. You just need to fill out an automatic check withdraw slip at the Front Desk and give them the information on the account you want the fees taken out of. Your Active Kids fee will come out the 1st of each month, and will continue to come out until you cancel your ACH payment - no refunds.

ACTIVE KIDS' GUIDELINES:

1. Please apply sunscreen & bug repellent as needed on your child before coming to Active Kids.
2. Dress your children appropriately! Light jackets may be needed and tennis shoes or closed-toe sandals are encouraged to prevent injury to little feet and toes.
3. Please send a water bottle with your children - labeled and full of water.
4. A Child Information Card must be filled out and updated regularly on each child.
5. Children must follow all YMCA guidelines and rules including no fighting and no pretend weapons. Children are expected to talk appropriately to staff, use manners, share, show patience, follow directions, take turns, help pick up toys, etc. If extreme behavior problems occur, children not be allowed to attend.
6. On water day, (weather permitting) children can wear their swimsuits under their clothes and bring a towel with name on it.
